Definition of work: The successful candidate for this position will supervise a caseload of clients within the Veterans Treatment Court (VTC) and justice-involved veterans on pretrial supervision. The candidate chosen will be required to prepare court reports, recommendations, and attend court to provide updates on clients' progress. They will administer risk/needs assessment tools and effectively case plan according to individual risk/needs. They will utilize solutions-based practices in administering effective sanctions to reduce recidivism and promote sobriety. They will engage in cognitive interventions through teaching, modeling, practicing, and encouragement to achieve positive outcomes. They will be knowledgeable in the VTC's policies, procedures, and requirements, including each phase's requirements to provide support and guidance throughout the VTC. They will create and maintain partnerships with various stakeholders and operate autonomously in a collaborative team environment. They will be versed in Mental Health and Substance Use Treatment programs offered by the U.S. Department of Veterans Affairs (VA) and community mental health partners. They will be competent and engage in continued education with topics including, military cultural competence, treatment court modalities, and trauma-informed interventions. The candidate chosen will be required to complete home and/or field visits on VTC clients and may be asked to work non-traditional hours in this role.

Required education and experience: Bachelor's degree in a social services field required. Minimum of one year working in the field of probation and/or corrections is preferred. Experience with treatment courts preferred. Adult risk needs certification preferred. Prior military experience is preferred.

Knowledge, Abilities, Skills: This position requires strong verbal and written communication skills and attention to detail. Interpersonal skills are required with the ability to interact respectfully with both clients and stakeholders. Knowledge of treatment court models and best practices in probation supervision is preferred. A familiarity with the role trauma, including mental health and substance use issues, play in the cognitive process is preferred. Ability to collaborate, engage, and solve complex problems in a team environment is required.

Other: Successful candidate must be able to pass a fingerprint-based criminal background check.
